

This issue of the Bulletin is a collection of 10 English papers presented at the conference "New Directions in Chinese Philosophy". The 3 English keynote speeches, respectively by Henry Rosemont, Jr., Roger Ames, and Donald Munro, form Part 1 of the Bulletin. Papers in Part 2 cover such topics as: Pre-Qin Confucianism, cognitive science and virtue ethics; "hearing" and "harmony" in Confucian self-cultivation; Tang Chun-I's philosophy of culture as a succession of the transformative dimension of Confucianism; interpretation of Zhuangzi's butterfly dream from symbolism and Jungian psychology; Wang Bi's notions of principle, centrality, and substance/function; Tang Chun-I's comparative philosophy; and Tang's interpretation of Liu Zongzhou's thought. This two-volume set shows scholars' bold attempts to explore new directions in Chinese philosophical studies, which make a meaningful response to Tang Chun-I's thought on "a new orientation for the study of Chinese philosophy."



吐露爭鳴：二零一四時事論叢



本書收錄了香港中文大學香港亞太研究所歷屆全人過去一學年（2014-14）在各大報章發表的其中 45 篇時評論文。

本書取題為「爭鳴」，就是要凸顯研究所全人對公眾議題的不同思考。文集所展現的除了專業、關注問題多元之外，就是立場與結論的多元。其中最能說明研究所全人如何以專業學術角度來應對公眾議題的，可能是在民意調查方面的評論，例如書中收錄與電話調查有關的回應率，與入戶調查的優劣問題；就社會上對政府官員，尤其是特首「民望」與表現評分的討論與批評，我們亦就搜集與發布民意數據的專業知識與經驗發表了看法，並說明我們以「分數」來量度特首民望的統計理據及其實質意義。

本書不代表研究所對時事、公眾議題的「官方立場」，可視為學者對推廣研究成果與專業知識的努力，希望對推動公眾討論有幫助。



香港和台灣同文同種，社經發展水平相若，兩地雖經歷百多年的政治區隔，但人民保持頻繁交往，經貿關係亦緊密，台港關係也隨兩岸關係改善而開始解凍。加強台港之間的溝通、瞭解和互動，除了是一個推動區域化可取的着力點，也有助雙方攜手因應中國影響力長驅直入兩地本土社會各領域的衝擊。

本書邀集兩地學者，就婚姻與家庭、社會問題、政治態度與價值，以及中國關係與效應等議題，探討和比較香港及台灣的發展經驗。各論文均運用最新的調查數據，對台港社會意向和民情動態提供客觀的數據、敏銳的觀察及深入的分析。



Development and Validation of the Chinese Sources of Parental Meaning Questionnaire

Siu-ming To, Siu-mee lu Kan, Kcon-wah Tsoi, & Ting-sam Chan

This research aimed to develop and validate a quantitative measure for the assessment of sources of parental meaning. A sample of 1,557 parents in Hong Kong were recruited to fill out a questionnaire comprising 27 items about different aspects of sources of parental meaning and other validation measures. An exploratory factor analysis on 799 randomly selected parents yielded a fourfold factor structure with 22 items. A confirmatory factor analysis on the remaining 758 parents demonstrated a good model fit. The factors revealed four categories of Chinese sources of parental meaning, including: (1) Child Nurturing, (2) Instrumental Consideration, (3) Marital Relationship, and (4) Self-enhancement. The findings show that these four factors were negatively associated with parental discontent and positively associated with parental efficacy. This scale can open up new directions for theory development, practice, and research.



Set in a county town in the interior of China in 1927, the year the Communists were crushed in the coastal cities and shifted their mobilizing efforts toward the rural hinterland, the novel captures the pervasive sense of uncertainty and anxiety which accompanied that momentous transformation. Beautifully translated by David Hull, this original 1928 version of Mao Dun's novel opens a revealing window onto the complex drama of social revolution. A radical sympathizer himself, Mao Dun nevertheless writes with extraordinary insight and empathy about the human anguish that revolutionary struggle entailed for so many of his fellow countrymen. This book belongs on the reading list of anyone seeking to understand the Chinese revolution at one of its most critical junctures.

《香港視覺藝術年鑑》於2000年初版，中英文雙語印行，圖文並茂，為迄今最全面的香港視覺藝術編年工具書。本書分為「專題論述」和「視藝記事」兩大部份，編集全本地藝術家於本地及海外的視藝活動，並結合學者專家的分析論文，一為宏觀主觀的觀察陳述；一為微觀客觀的數據縷述，兩者互相依存，互為補充。

Ten years have gone by since the Hong Kong Visual Arts Yearbook was launched in 2000. Bilingual in Chinese and English, it is the most comprehensive annalistic toolbook for Hong Kong Visual Arts, with the aid of photos. The Yearbook is composed of two sections: "Essays" and "Chronicles" the former is made up of commissioned essays by academic experts who draw comprehensive commentaries while pinpointing selective local visual arts events; while the latter gathers and catalogues all types of visual arts events of the year. One is subjective observation and analysis on a broad scope, while the other is microscopic listing of objective data; both are interdependent on as well as complementary to each other.






基督教信仰與公共選擇：巴特、布倫納與朋霍費爾的社會倫理

Born in Nanking, China, and educated at Dulwich College, UK, Sir George Macartney was of mixed Scottish-Chinese parentage. As the British agent, based in remote Kashgar on the Silk Road, he was caught up in the 19th and early 20th century power-struggle amongst Britain, China and Russia over control of Central Asia, engaging with the scheming Russian Consul Nicolai Petrovsky. Aply and courageously accompanied by his British wife, Catherine, his life was otherwise solitary, punctuated by hazardous journeys made with their family when travelling to and from the United Kingdom on leave. Occasional visitors recognised that only George Macartney, with his renowned tact, diplomacy, and steely determination, could have maintained the British position with so little external support. His dangerous encounter leading a mission to the Bolshevik revolutionaries in Tashkent made for a dramatic finale to his extraordinary career in a restive region now causing concern to the Chinese government.
